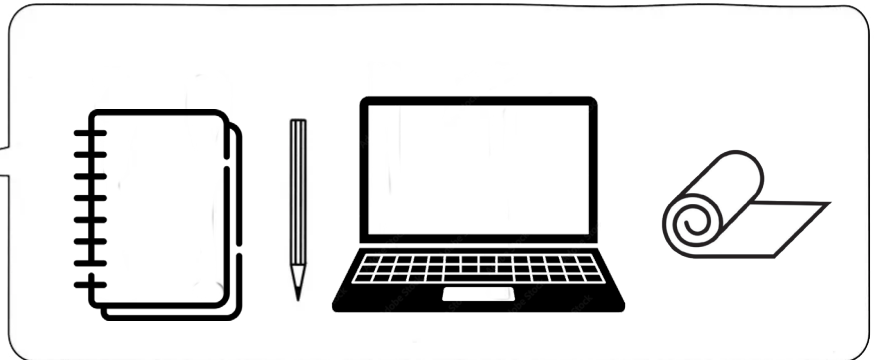


APPLICATION STEP BY STEP



1



Have you successfully completed your bachelor's degree in Architecture, Urban Planning, Landscape Planning, or related disciplines, or do you still have up to 30 credit points (CP) outstanding?

2



Submit your application on time via the digital campus management system CaMS. A postal application is not required.

3



You will receive an invitation to the selection process via email. This may be sent at short notice. Please check all your mail folders (including spam) for messages

4



Take part in a successful aptitude interview, during which we will discuss a project that demonstrates your particular interest in and suitability for the master's program. You will receive information about the date and location in the invitation email.

5



Please check the status of your application regularly in the campus management portal. Note that processing may take up to three weeks. You can view the admission decisions in the portal.

6



If you are admitted, you will receive all further instructions for enrollment. Note: by that time, your bachelor's degree must be successfully completed.

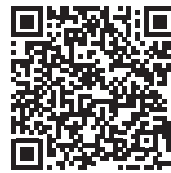

Do I need to prepare/submit/upload a portfolio for the application?



No, a portfolio is not required for our application process. Also, no portfolio with work samples is needed for the aptitude interview.

I have not yet completed my degree. Can I still apply? Are there any exceptions?



Yes, you can apply. Up to 30 credit points (CP) from your bachelor's degree may still be outstanding at the end of the application period; however, they must be fully completed and documented by the time of enrollment.

Since I cannot be on site, would it be possible to conduct the interview online?



We would prefer to meet you in person on site. In justified exceptional cases, the aptitude interview can take place digitally.

Under what circumstances do I have to apply through uni-assist?



For international applicants, a special application procedure with an earlier deadline applies. If you hold a bachelor's or diploma degree, which is related to the master's program and was obtained abroad, the application must be submitted through uni-assist.



How is the aptitude interview conducted?



The interview lasts approximately 10 minutes per person and focuses primarily on your personal motivation. The commission consists of professors, WMA staff, and students of the master's program.

How do I enroll for the study place, and which documents do I need to submit?



With the admission letter, you will receive detailed information from the university about the enrollment procedure and the required documents.
